

CEJI is looking for one Dutch-speaking student in Belgium to help monitor online environments.

Background/Purpose

In the framework of the EU-funded project [SafeNet](#), CEJI is looking for one Dutch-speaking student to monitor hate speech online with a specific focus on Belgium. The student will work with two staff members to develop, customise, and update a list of keywords to inform the monitoring work, as well as to participate in monitoring exercise of hateful content on social media platforms.

Specific tasks include

- Participation in a 2-hours online module on understanding and countering hate speech;
- Development and update a lexicon to identify hate speech online;
- Monitoring online spaces and social platforms;
- Keeping track of online reports and data from monitoring exercises.

Skill/Requirements

- Currently enrolled at an accredited college or university
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Office programs including Word, Excel, and basic database management experience.
- Good knowledge of social platforms functioning (including but not limited to Facebook, X – formerly known as Twitter –, TikTok, YouTube).
- Excellent organisational and interpersonal skills.
- Resourceful, determined, and diligent in the search for information.
- Detail-oriented in notetaking and keeping good records.
- Proactive to take initiative and solve problems.
- Interest and a good understanding of the manifestations of discrimination.
- Ability to work independently and with an international team.

Profile: fluent Dutch, and English.

What we offer: The opportunity to work in the field of social activism, monitoring and fighting discrimination. We aim to provide true learning and development opportunities in the aforementioned areas of focus.

This is a paid role following student contract.

Duration: This role is scheduled for the months of September and October.

Hours: 15 hours per week, with flexible days to be determined later.
